Shelter

If a young person (18-24) is experiencing homelessness call 513-381-7233 (SAFE) for access to shelter beds around the city.

Outreach Services

If a young person is experiencing homelessness they may be served by the Youth Outreach Program. The Youth Outreach Program can come out and meet the young person where they are and provide access to shelter, referrals to housing, immediate access to clothing, water, food, hygiene and harm reduction products, referrals to mental health and substance abuse services.
